Nanofabrica's vision is to harness the power of Additive Manufacturing (AM) for mass manufacturing. Specifically, we are in the area of precision AM or micro AM. The company has raised 2 financing rounds, filed patents, shipped 2 Beta systems to real paying customers, and has a great team. The startup was recently acquired by Nanodimension for around \$6

In the talk I will tell the story of how we launched a deep tech, HW based startup, and got to an exit. I'll try to share aspects that surprised me about entrepreneurship.

BIO: Jon earned his PhD in nano optics in the group of Romain Quidant at ICFO Spain following a double degree from TAU (Tel-Aviv University) in physics and electrical engineering. He then worked at KTT leading a spin off of an electro optical device. In 2016 Jon Founded Nanofabrica and acted as its CEO.
